Alaskans Can Now Bid on 152 Parcels in State Land Auction

(Anchorage, AK) – The Department of Natural Resources (DNR) is inviting Alaska residents interested in owning a piece of the Last Frontier to participate in the 2026 Alaska State Land Auction, Offering #498, which includes 152 road-accessible or remote parcels throughout the state.

Alaskans may submit sealed bids online, in person, or by mail through September 30 at 4 p.m. Apparent high bids will be announced on October 21. Bidders may win and purchase up to two parcels. Parcels not sold at auction may be available through Over-the-Counter (OTC) sales to Alaska residents, non-residents, or businesses, starting on Nov. 18 at 10 a.m. DNR offers competitive in-house financing for land purchases; for more information please visit: <https://dnr.alaska.gov/mlw/landsales/info/financing/>.
