Alaska Board of Forestry Meeting is August 4

(Anchorage, AK) – Members of the media and the public are invited to participate in the next Board of Forestry meeting on Tuesday, August 4, 2026, starting at 8:00 a.m. The public comment period will begin at 1:00 p.m.

The nine-member Board of Forestry advises the Commissioner of the Department of Natural Resources on forestry regulations, provides a forum for those interested in forestry to discuss and seek resolution of issues concerning Alaska's forest resources, and makes recommendations to the Governor and Legislature on research needs.

Topics on the Board's agenda for this meeting include:

- Forestry and forest practices-related legislation and budget updates
- State and federal forest management issues (including reports on Mental Health Trust and U.S. Forest Service forestry activity, Division of Forestry & Fire Protection timber sales, and other timber related initiatives)
- Carbon Program Update
- Alaska Forest Association update
- Public Comment
