The subject state land is located on Cohoe Loop Road near Clam Gulch in the Kenai Peninsula Borough. The legal description of the subject parcel is that portion of the South ½ of the Southeast ¼ of Section 10, Township 2 North, Range 12 West, Seward Meridian lying west of the right-of-way of Cohoe Loop Road

A 55 year lease was originally issued for the parcel in 1974 and will expire in 2029. Jon and Valerie Swanson are the current lessees. The Swansons own the improvements located on the parcel and intend to reside there.
