The Department of Natural Resources (DNR), Division of Mining, Land and Water, Land Sales and Contract Administration Section (LSCAS), proposes the closure of state lands to mineral entry within ASLS 2014-44, Riverwood Subdivision, which is located 10 miles northeast of Fairbanks along the Chena River. This area includes 6 parcels to be offered for sale. The total amount of land affected will be 30 acres, more or less.
