GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Hours of operation are 10 am 8 pm. The range is closed every Wednesday.
- 2. Vehicles are not allowed on the range.
- 3. Shot-shells (of any sort), tracer, incendiary, or explosive/cracker rounds are not allowed.
- 4. Fully automatic weapons, explosives, cannons, .50 caliber center fire rifles and non-firearms are not allowed.
- 5. Only authorized targets, such as paper, wood, or clay targets may be used (no aerial targets). Targets must be placed between the minimum distances and the backstops. The State reserves sole discretion to allow/disallow a target.

Minimum Distance for <u>25yd Range</u> is: **3 yards** Minimum Distance for <u>100yd Range</u> is: **10 yards**

- 6. No fires of any sort are allowed on site.
- 7. No use or consumption of alcohol, marijuana, or drugs is allowed on site.
- 8. Please wear proper safety equipment. People acting in an unsafe manner will have to leave the site.
- 9. Be sure your weapon is safe to operate and you know how to use it.

FIRING LINE RULES AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Treat every weapon as if it were loaded.
- 2. Never point your weapon at anything you do not intend to shoot.
- 3. Keep your finger off the trigger until you are ready to fire.
- 4. Keep your weapon on safe until you intend to fire.
- 5. Be aware of your target's foreground and background.
- 6. Designate a range officer when none are present or assigned.
- 7. While on the firing line always point your weapon down range. Weapons may only be fired from the established firing line.
- 8. Unload, remove magazine, open action, and place all firearms on the ground or bench during a cease fire. **DO NOT HANDLE ANY FIREARM OR STAND AT THE FIRING LINE WHILE OTHERS ARE DOWN RANGE**.
- 9. Keep all unsecured firearms unloaded until ready for use.
- 10. Clean up your lane of fire when you are done; this includes all shell casings, targets, and debris.
- 11. Ground targets are not authorized. Targets must be an appropriate height so all rounds will impact the backstop without ricocheting off the ground.
