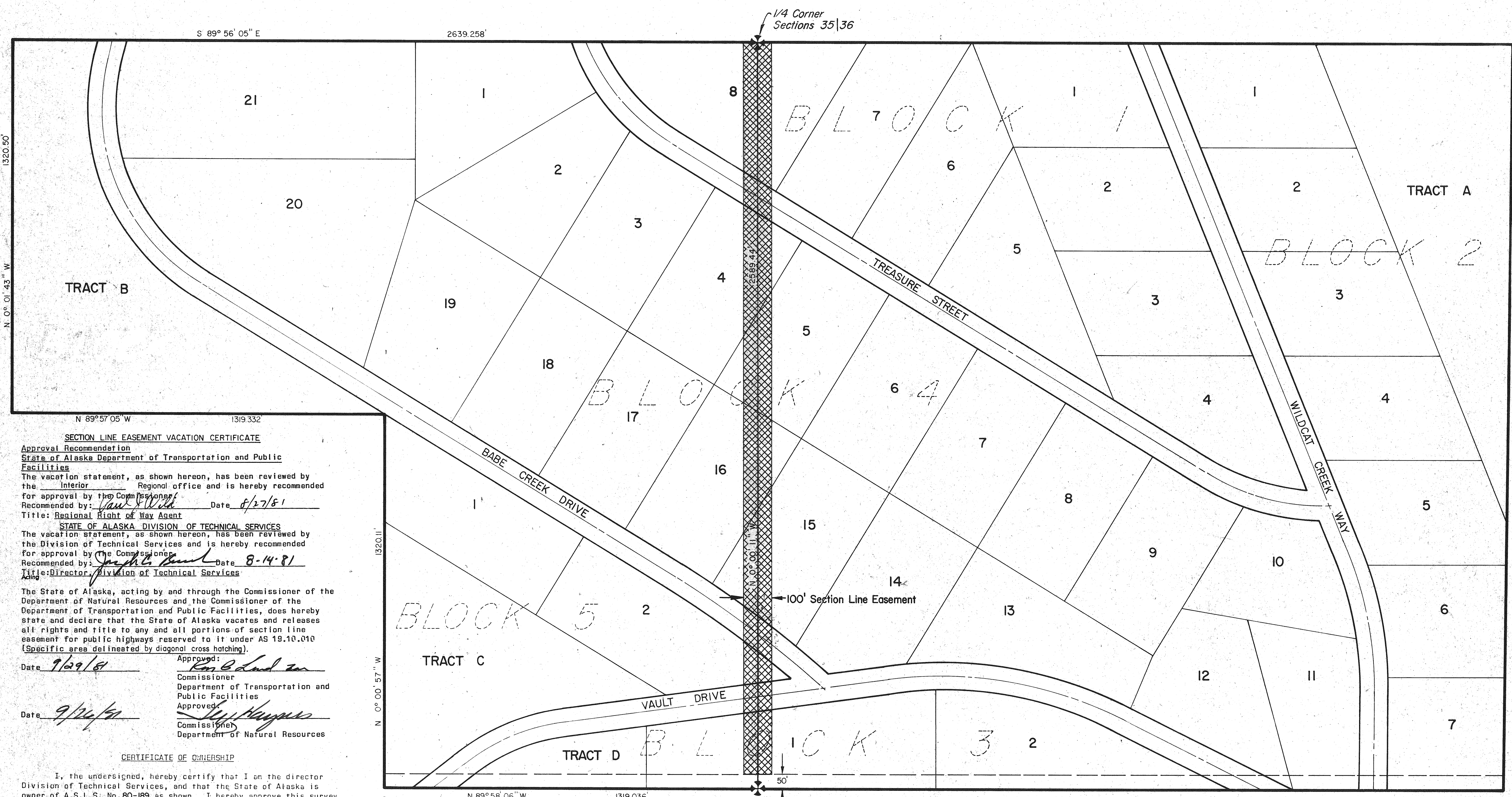


VICINITY MAP



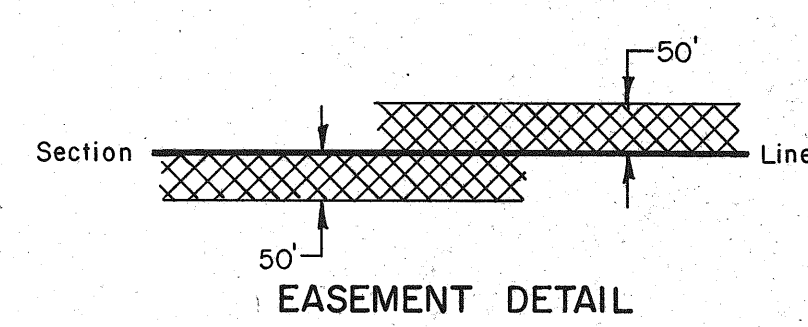
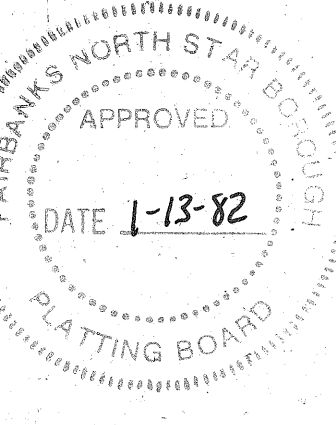
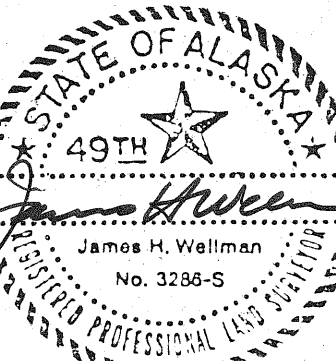
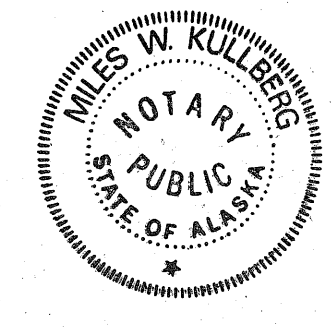

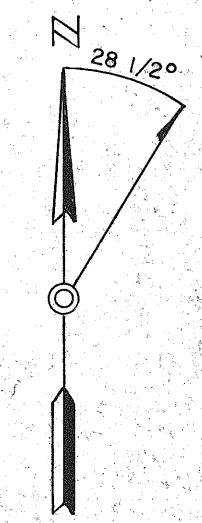
