To Ed Fogels:

Pursuant to AS 16.05.841 (Fishway Act), the Alaska Department of Fish and Game (ADF&G), Habitat Section has reviewed your request to access drill sites near your Graphite Creek camp with small equipment and/or large ATVs in support of your hardrock exploration operation. Your proposed access route may cross Graphite Creek and headwater tributary, and a tributary of Glacier Canyon Creek.

In accordance with AS 16.05.841, your project is approved subject to the original project description and permit terms, with the following stipulation:

- 1) Summer stream crossings with equipment and ATVs shall be made from bank to bank in a direction substantially perpendicular to the direction of stream flow to the extent practicable. Equipment crossings shall be made in a manner that precludes creation of barriers to efficient fish passage (ridging and/or rutting of streambed, etc.). No modifications to the banks of the stream are authorized via this permit.

All terms and conditions of the original permit remain in effect.
