The Trust Land Office (TLO) has completed its review and evaluation of the information contained in your Plan of Operations for the Palmer Project – Phase II Underground Exploration for the Upland Mining Lease No. 9100759 dated April 2019 that describes your proposed activities on the above referenced lease.

In addition, the TLO reviewed conditions and stipulations of Waste Management Permit 2019DB001 that covers disposal of exploration wastes at the Palmer Project as well as containment, monitoring, reclamation and closure activities, and financial assurance for site reclamation at closure. Waste Management Permit 2019DB001 was issued on July 17, 2019 by the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC). Further, the TLO reviewed conditions and stipulations of the Reclamation Plan Approval (RPA) No. J20185690RPA for the Palmer Project issued by the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) – Division of Mining, Land and Water on July 17, 2019. Also, the TLO reviewed the response to comments received on DEC's Waste Management Permit No. 2019DB001 and DNR's Reclamation Plan Approval No. J20185690RPA dated July 17, 2019.

Pursuant to Section 11 of the Lease, the Trust Land Office approves your Plan of Operations. Note that this approval, as provided for in Section 11 of the Lease, does not relieve you as the Lessee of your obligation to obtain all approvals and permits that may be required by governmental agencies having regulatory authority over your proposed activities.
