16. LAND USE

Kevin Waring Associates will complete the baseline description of land use for the area potentially affected by project development and operations associated with the Pebble Project.

The objectives, study area, and methods of the land use study are unchanged from those described in the 2005 study plan and 2006 addendum.

The scope of the land use description reflects the latest information on land use and ownership. The information on ongoing land use planning and management activities of federal and state governments will be current as of the time of the report. Most particularly, the 2007 land use study will address the following:

- Any recent revisions to state and local coastal management programs.
- The status of the Bureau of Land Management Rim of Fire and Bay Resource Management Plans.
- Revisions to local governmental comprehensive plans and land use regulations.
- Other ongoing state, local, and federal land use and transportation plans.

Table 16-1 provides a summary of tasks for the land use study in 2005 through 2007.
