Subject: Pogo Mine Plan of Operations Approval Amendment 8 F20189500POOA.08 for Liese Creek Bypass Culvert Installation

Dear Mr. Coxon:

On August 26, 2021, the Division of Mining, Land, and Water, Mining Section (DMLW) received correspondence from Northern Star (Pogo) LLC requesting approval to amend the Pogo Mine Plan of Operations Approval (POOA 20189500). Pogo is requesting to add a bypass road and culvert over Liese Creek adjacent to the existing bridge crossing. Additionally, Pogo will eventually remove the existing Liese Creek bridge and install a culvert to complete the widening of the road.

We reviewed the requested amendments and consulted with Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC), and the Alaska Department of Fish & Game (ADF&G). No objections to the proposed amendment have been received. ADF&G does require that the proposed culverts be designed and installed in a manner as to enable fish passage.

The requested amendment to your Plan of Operations (F20189500), as described and illustrated in your submissions listed above is hereby approved as Pogo Mine Plan of Operations Amendment Approval F20189500POOA.08. Nothing in this decision changes the conditions of the original Plan of Operations Approval dated May 26, 2018. The above listed changes should be accounted for in the next major update to the Plan and the reclamation cost estimate.



A person affected by this decision may appeal it, in accordance with 11 AAC 02. Any appeal must be received within 20 calendar days after the date of "issuance" of this decision, as defined in 11 AAC 02.040(c) and (d) and may be mailed or delivered to the Commissioner, Department

of Natural Resources, 550 W. 7th Avenue, Suite 1400, Anchorage, Alaska 99501; faxed to 1-907-269-8918, or sent by electronic mail to dnr.appeals@alaska.gov. Under 11 AAC 02.030, appeals and requests for reconsideration filed under 11 AAC 02 must be accompanied by the fee established in 11 AAC 05.160(d)(1)(F), which has been set at \$200 under the provisions of 11 AAC 05.160 (a) and (b).

This decision takes effect immediately. If no appeal is filed by the appeal deadline, this decision becomes a final administrative order and decision of the department on the 31st calendar day after issuance. An eligible person must first appeal this decision in accordance with 11 AAC 02 before appealing this decision to Superior Court. A copy of 11 AAC 02 may be obtained from any regional information office of the Department of Natural Resources.
