the right to develop the following use of water:

Source: Main Stem Red Dog Creek

Quantity: 2000.00 acre-feet per year  
From: January 1st through December 31st  
Use: metal mining

with a PRIORITY DATE of April 24, 1987.

The location of this water source:

Main Stem of Red Dog Creek within the below described parcel.

The location to which this appropriation is appurtenant:

The Red Dog Mine located within protracted Sections 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9, Township 30 North, Range 18 West, Kateel River Meridian, protracted Sections 1, 2, 11, 12, 13, and 14, Township 30 North, Range 19 West, Kateel River Meridian, and protracted Sections 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, and 33, Township 31 North, Range 18 West, Kateel River Meridian.

**PERMIT  
TO  
APPROPRIATE WATER**

**LAS 25095**

Changes in the natural state of water are to be made in the manner and only for the purposes stated in this permit. This permit is subject to the pertinent statutory provisions in AS 46.15, Administrative Regulations in 11 AAC 93, and the following conditions:

The holder of this permit shall:

1. Follow acceptable engineering standards in exercising the privilege granted by this permit.
2. Except for claims or losses arising from negligence of the State, defend and indemnify the State against and hold it harmless from any and all claims, demands, legal actions, loss, liability and expense for injury to or death of persons and damages to or loss of property arising out of or connected with the exercise of this permit.
3. Comply with all applicable laws, regulations and conditions.
4. Notify the GRANTOR of any change of address of the GRANTEE or transfer of any real property identified in this permit.
5. This permit is subject to an annual administrative service fee in accordance to 11 AAC 05.010(a)(8)(M).
6. Establish a metering system acceptable to the Water Resources Section and submit records to the Water Resources Section on an annual basis.
7. Where practical, excess surface water from the Red Dog Creek drainage that is not needed for the mining operation shall be diverted from contact with the disturbed mineralized areas of the mine.

This permit shall EXPIRE on: May 31, 2022.

This permit to appropriate water is issued by authority of AS 46.15.080 and 11 AAC 93.120 on:
