The State of Alaska filed a Motion and Memorandum in Support of Determination of Prevailing Party for Purposes of Costs at **Docket**. **33**. The United States opposed that motion at Docket 32. Having considered the parties' briefings, and for the reasons stated in *Alaska v. United States*, 2016 WL 1948801 (D.
