ALASKA CONSTITUTION AND STATE STATUTES

Article VIII § 1 - It is the policy of the State to encourage the settlement of its land and the development of its resources by making them available for maximum use consistent with the public interest.

Article VIII § 2 - The legislature shall provide for the utilization, development, and conservation of all natural resources belonging to the State, including land and waters, for the maximum benefit of its people

The Alaska Legislature enacted numerous statutes to implement Article VIII of the Constitution. For DNR, many of the statutes affecting use and management of public domain lands and waters are within **Title 38 of the Alaska Statutes**.

The policy for use and classification of State lands is provided in **Alaska Statutes 38.04.005, .010, and .015**.

MISSIONS OF DNR AND DMLW

- **DNR's mission:** Develop, conserve and maximize the use of Alaska's natural resources consistent with the public interest.
- **DMLW's Mission:** To provide for the appropriate use and management of Alaska's state owned land and water, aiming toward maximum use consistent with the public interest

Remote Recreation Cabin Sites

Lottery program to stake it yourself within a designated area.



Subdivision Sales

DNR designed and surveyed parcels to the public.



Agricultural Land Sales

Productive land sold to support agriculture and food security.



Over the Counter Purchases

Smaller parcels available for purchase without a formal application or auction.



Municipal Entitlements

Land conveyed to municipalities to support community needs and growth.



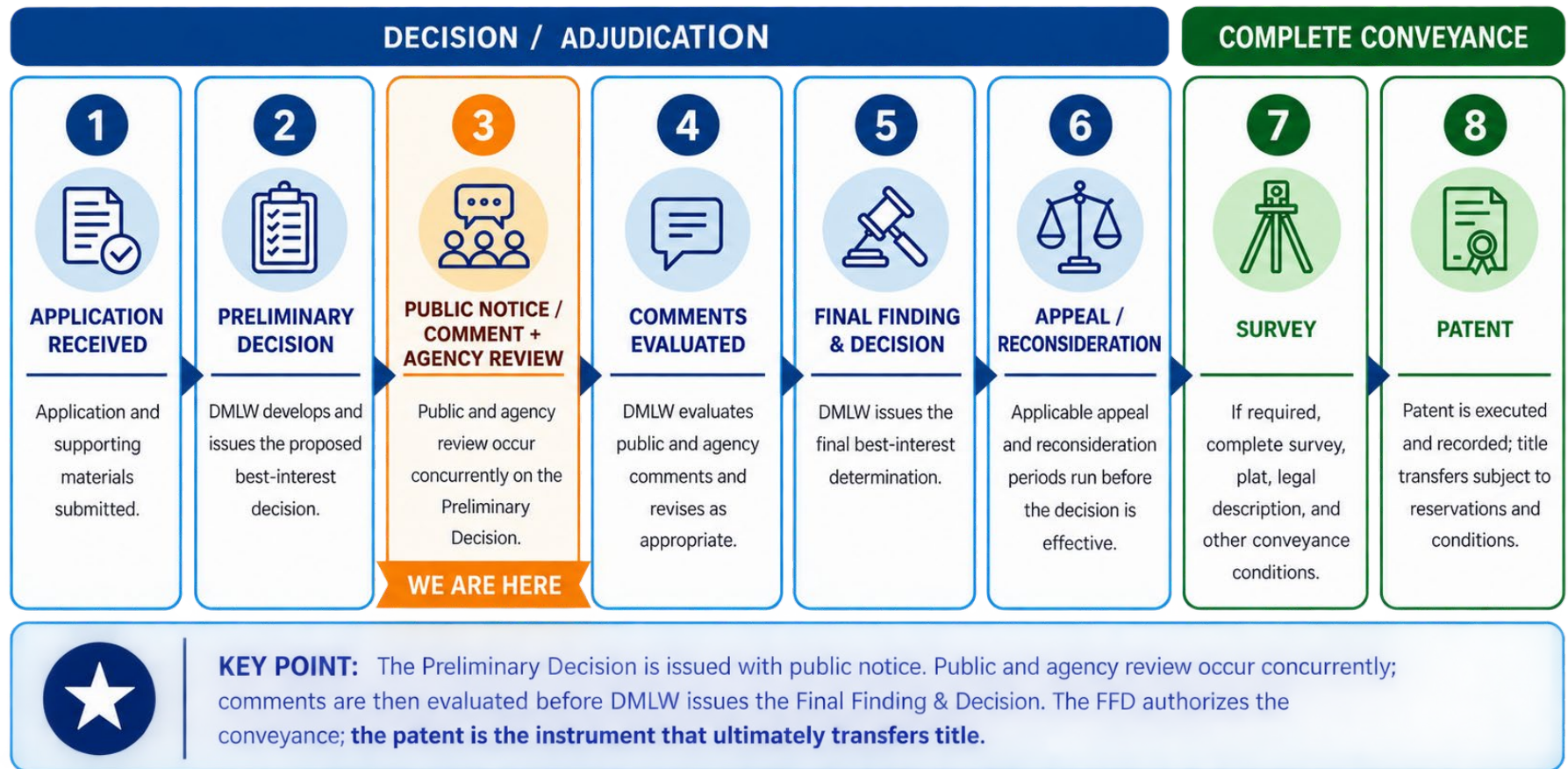
Public & Charitable

Public and charitable conveyances for a variety of federal, state, local, and nonprofit agencies.

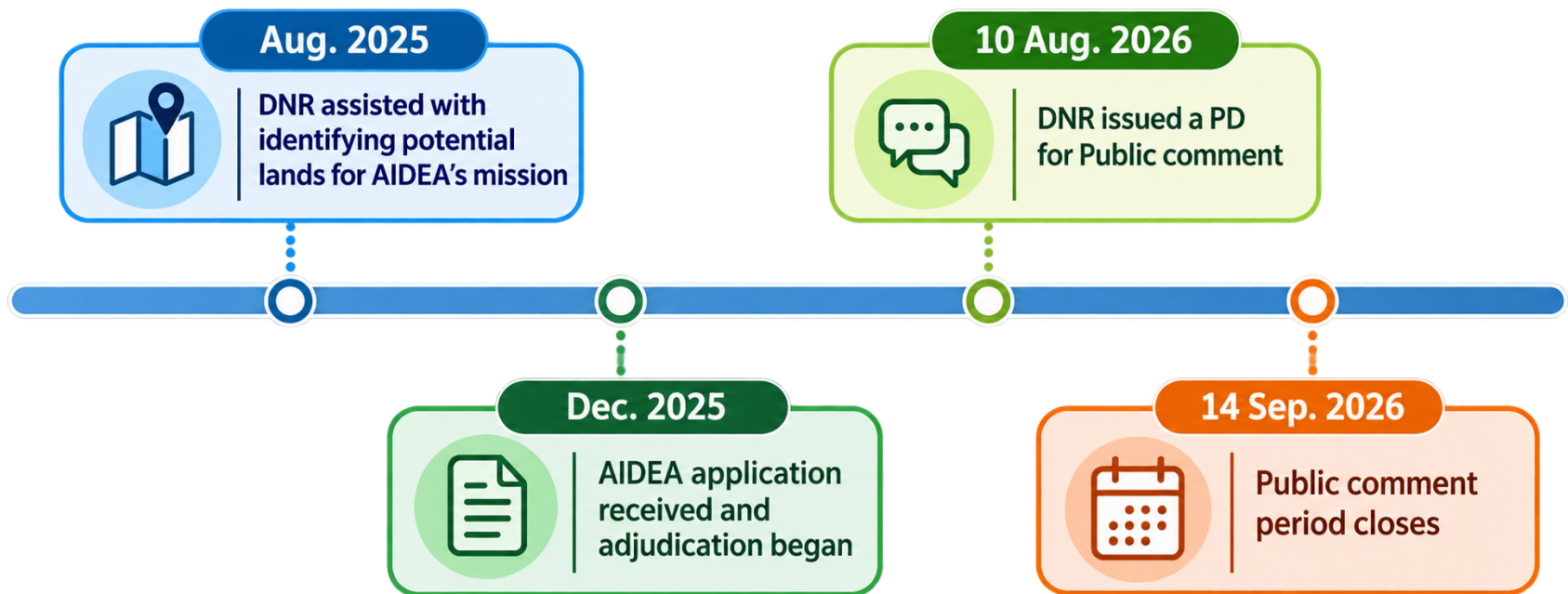


Conveyances are subject to applicable statutes, regulations, planning, classification, and appraisal requirements, and available lands. This is not an exhaustive list.

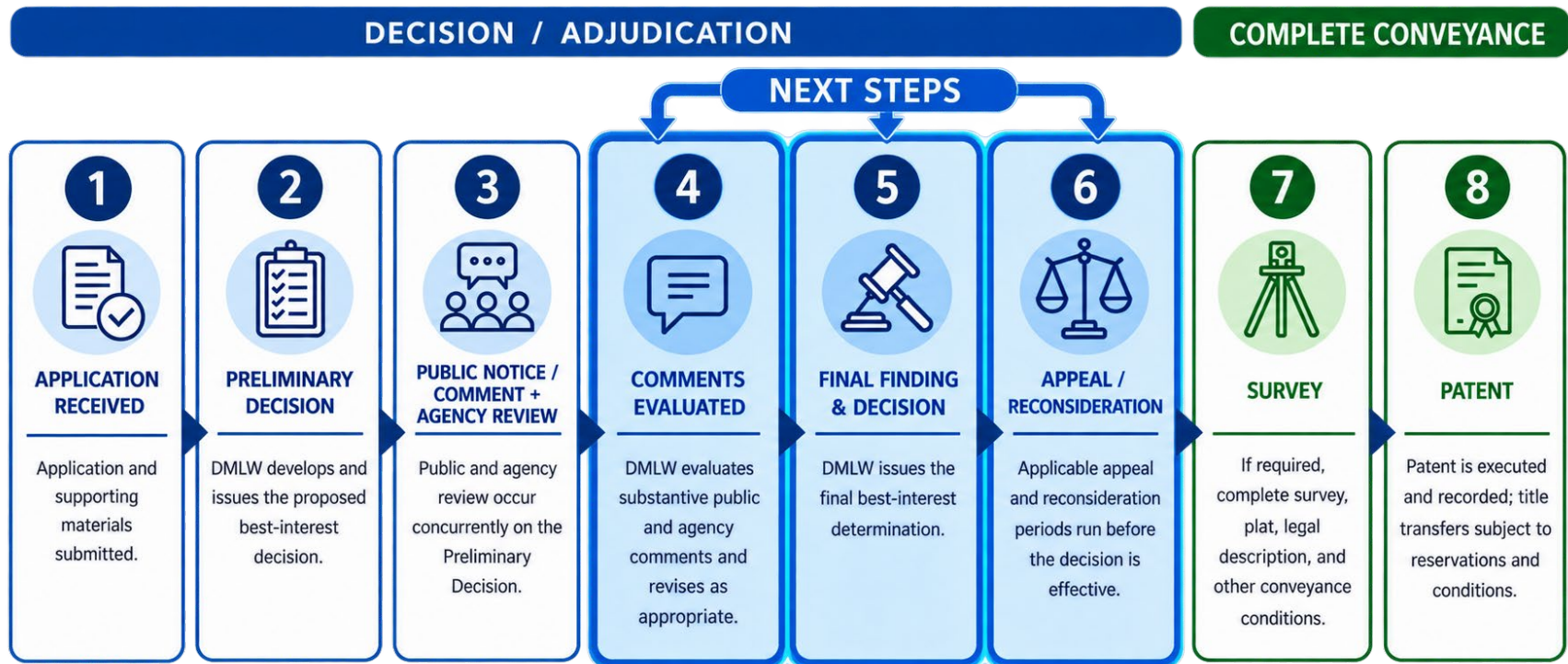
GENERAL CONVEYANCE PROCESS
