

## AFOGNAK A-3 (1 of 2)

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### ◆ RESERVED EASEMENTS

#### **Afognak Bay Road**

A trail on the existing road running westerly from the head of Kazakof Bay. Legal access provided by EIN 22 and ANILCA 1427(b)(5).

#### **EIN 1**

A proposed trail from the former Navy Recreation Camp on the north side of Afognak Lake westerly to trail easements EIN 22, EIN 2, and EIN 4. (25-foot trail)

#### **EIN 2**

A proposed trail running southerly from the head of Afognak Lake at site EIN 5. (25-foot trail)

#### **EIN 4**

An existing trail from Muskomee Bay at site EIN 24 northeasterly to Afognak Lake at site EIN 5. (25-foot trail)

#### **EIN 5**

A campsite on the shore of Afognak Lake at the head of the lake. (one-acre site)

#### **EIN 6**

A campsite on the shore of Malina Bay at the head of the bay. (one-acre site)

#### **EIN 20**

A proposed trail running east from trail EIN 22-1. (25-foot trail)

#### **EIN 21**

A proposed trail running southerly from trail EIN 22-1. (25-foot trail)

#### **EIN 22-1**

A proposed trail from existing Afognak Bay Road southerly to Back Bay and Afognak Bay. (25-foot trail)

#### **EIN 22-2**

A proposed trail from Afognak Lake at site EIN 5 to Malina Bay at site EIN 31. (25-foot trail)

#### **EIN 22a**

A proposed trail southerly from Malina Bay at site EIN 27a. (25-foot trail)

#### **EIN 24**

A campsite on the north shore of Raspberry Strait near Waskanareska Bay. (25-foot trail)

#### **EIN 24a**

A proposed trail running easterly from Raspberry Strait at site EIN 24. (25-foot trail)

#### **EIN 25**

A proposed trail running northerly from Raspberry Strait at site EIN 24. (25-foot trail)

#### **EIN 26**

A proposed trail running southerly from Afognak Bay Road. (25-foot trail)

#### **EIN 27**

A proposed trail from trail EIN 22-1 to Malina Bay at site EIN 27a. (25-foot trail)

### ◆ RESERVED EASEMENTS:

#### **EIN 27a**

A campsite on the south shore of Malina Bay. (one-acre site)

#### **EIN 28**

A proposed trail near the head of Malina Bay running southwesterly from trail EIN 27. (25-foot trail)

#### **EIN 29**

A proposed trail running westerly from trail EIN 22-1. (25-foot trail)

#### **EIN 31**

A campsite on the shore of Malka Bay at the head of the bay. (one-acre site)

#### **EIN 33**

A proposed trail running northwesterly from trail EIN 22-1. (25-foot trail)

#### **EIN 37**

A proposed trail running northwesterly from trail EIN 29. (25-foot trail)

#### **EIN 39**

A proposed trail running northwesterly from Afognak Bay Road. (25-foot trail)

#### **EIN 53**

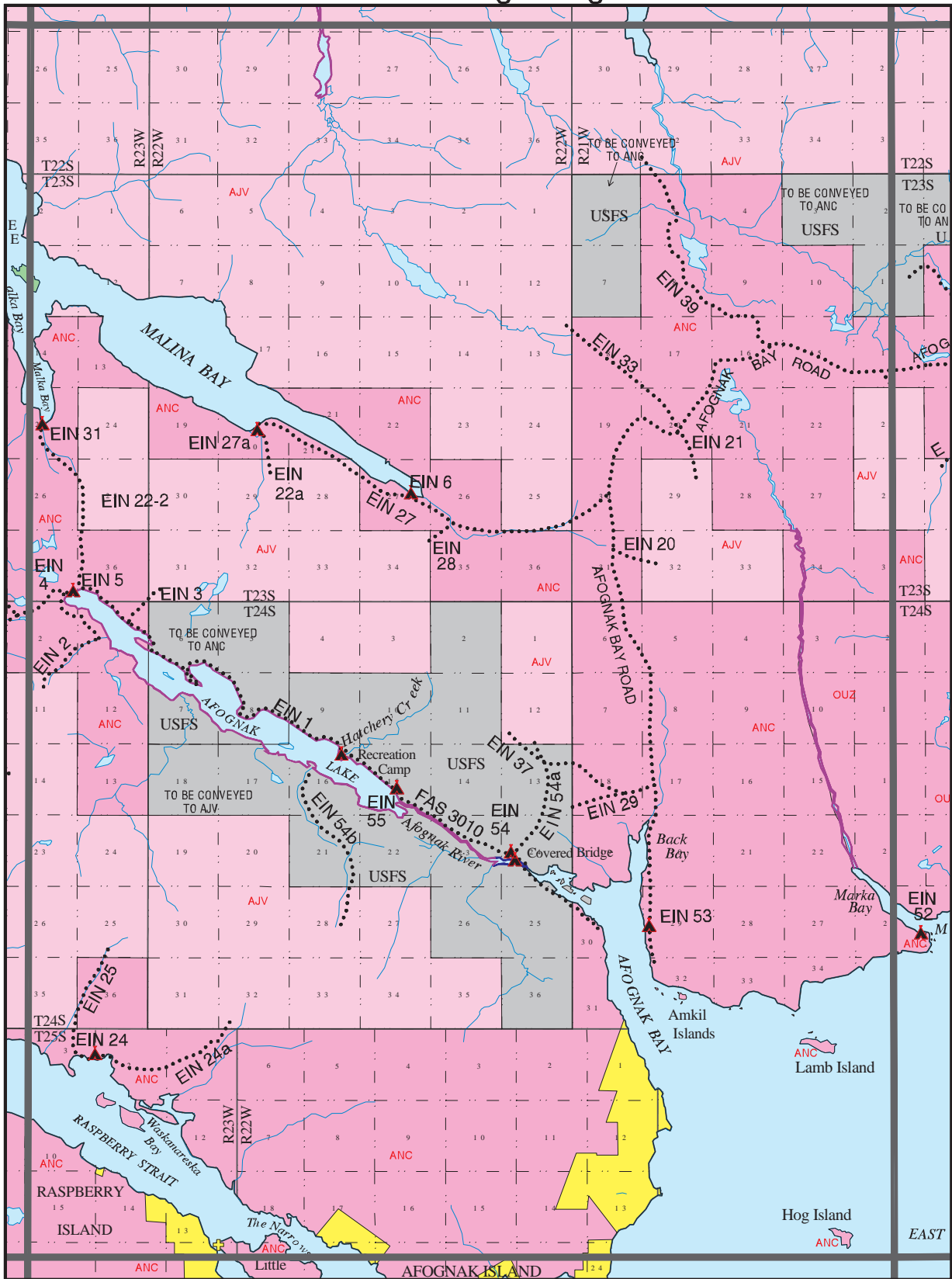
A campsite along Afognak Bay Road. (one-acre site) Easement to be donated after appeal settled.

#### **FAS 3910**

A road easement 100 feet in width from Rivermouth Point northwesterly to Hatchery River.
