◆ RESERVED EASEMENTS:

ADL 225832a

A proposed trail 25 feet in width running from Dog Bay (local name) at site ADL 225832b northeasterly along the shore of the bay to the mouth of an unnamed stream and then northwesterly generally along the west side of the unnamed stream.

ADL 225832b

A campsite one acre in size on Dog Bay (local name). This site serves as trailhead for trail ADL 225832a.

ADL 225855a

A campsite one acre in size on the shore of Kiliuda Bay.

ADL 225855b

An existing trail from Kiliuda Bay northeasterly to an unnamed stream (trail easement is 25 feet in width).

ADL 226540a

A proposed trail 50 feet in width along the shore of Kiliuda Bay.

ADL 226551a

A proposed trail 25 feet in width on each side of a clear water stream running westerly from Kiliuda Bay.

ADL 226551b

A campsite one acre in size at or near the mouth of the clearwater stream where it enters Kiliuda Bay.

ADL 226551c

A proposed trail 50 feet in width along the shore of Kiliuda Bay.

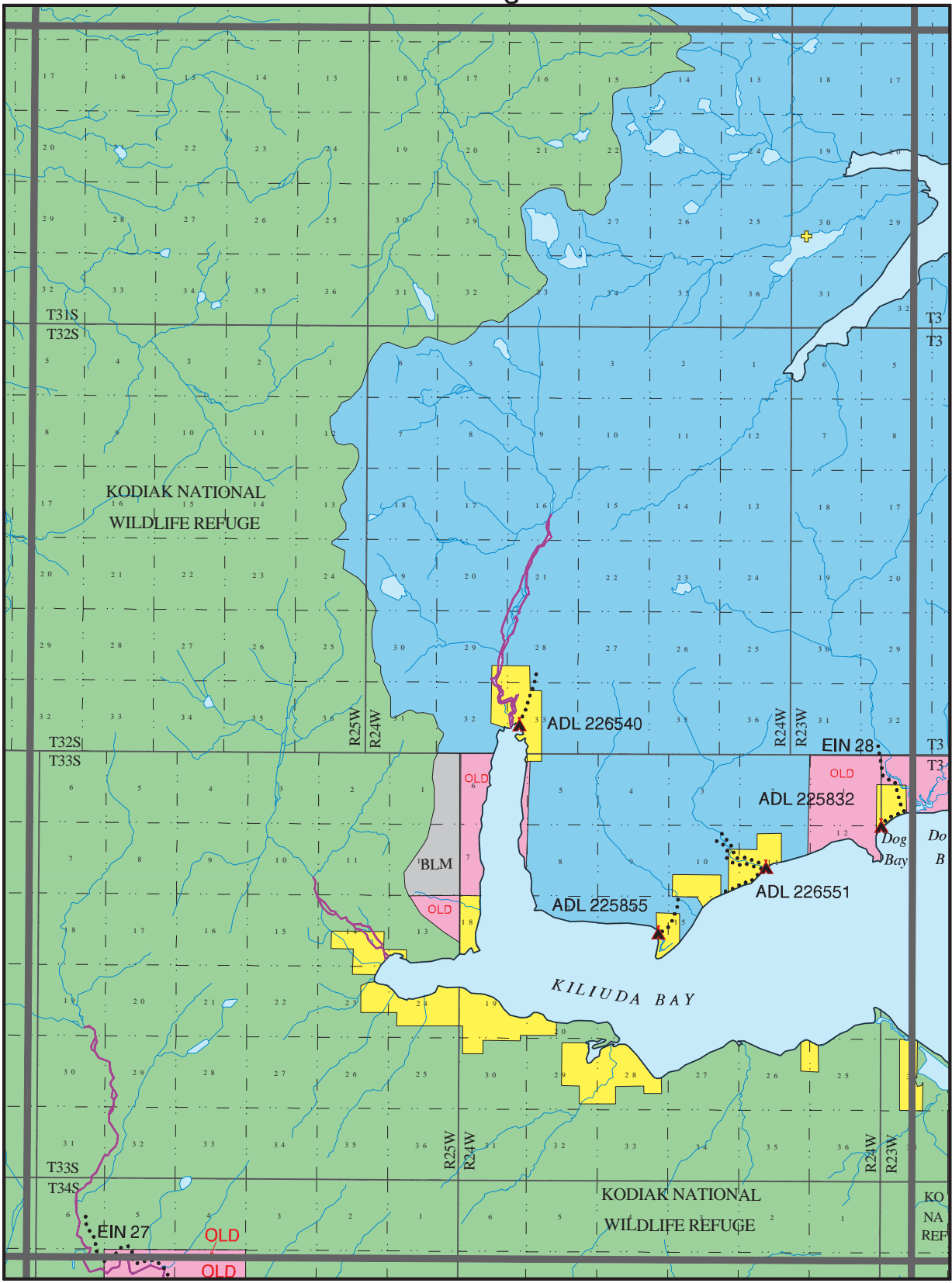
EIN 27

A proposed trail from Midway Bay at site EIN 13 northwesterly along the left bank of an unnamed stream. (25-foot trail)

EIN 28

A proposed trail from ADL 225832 running northerly.
