

## KODIAK C-2 (1 of 2)

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### ◆ RESERVED EASEMENTS:

#### Saltery Cove Road

Legal access provided by FAS 3912. One-hundred foot wide right-of-way. (Omnibus Road)

#### EIN 8

A proposed trail from Anton Larsen Road at Red Cloud Creek southerly to Cope Mountain and then continuing westerly. (25-foot trail)

#### EIN 20a

A proposed trail from campsite EIN 20b northerly to the shore of Womens Bay. (25-foot trail)

#### EIN 20b

A campsite adjacent to the Kodiak Island Highway at Womens Bay. (one-acre site)

#### EIN 24

A campsite on the west shore of Middle Bay. (one-acre site) GPS coordinates of the NW corner are Lat 57° 39' 34.3"N Long 152° 30' 29.9"W

#### EIN 24a

An existing road from Kodiak Island Highway southerly to campsite EIN 24. (60-foot road)

#### EIN 25

An existing trail from the Kodiak Island Highway to the mouth of the American River. (25-foot trail)

#### EIN 25a

A campsite adjacent to the Kodiak Island Highway at the American River Bridge. (one-acre site) GPS coordinates of the NW corner are Lat 57° 38' 30.0"N Long 152° 30' 37.5"W

#### EIN 28b

A campsite on the west shore of Kalsin Bay between the beach and Kodiak Island Highway. (one-acre site)

#### EIN 29a

An existing trail running southwesterly from site EIN 29d. (25-foot trail)

#### EIN 29d

A campsite at the junction of trail EIN 29a and road EIN 29e. (one-acre site)

#### EIN 29e

An existing road from Kodiak Island Highway southerly to site EIN 29d. (60-foot road) GPS coordinates are Lat 57° 35' 21.0"N Long 152° 28' 31.0"W

#### EIN 32

An existing road from Kodiak Island Highway east of Kalsin Creek northerly to Kalsin Lagoon. (60-foot road) GPS coordinates are Lat 57° 35' 15.0"N Long 152° 26' 44.0"W

#### EIN 32a

A campsite adjacent to Kalsin Lagoon at the end of road EIN 32. (one-acre site) GPS coordinates of the NW corner are Lat 57° 35' 27.0"N Long 152° 26' 32.0"W

#### EIN 48a

An existing trail from Pasagshak Point Road and campsite EIN 48d easterly to the Sacramento River Valley. (25-foot trail) GPS coordinates for the NW corner are Lat 57° 32' 20.6"N Long 152° 27' 33.7"W

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### ◆ RESERVED EASEMENTS:

#### **EIN 48d**

A campsite adjacent to Pasagshak Point Road. (one-acre site) GPS coordinates of the NW corner are Lat 57° 32' 23.2"N Long 152° 27' 37.7"W

#### **EIN 105**

An existing trail running from the Kodiak Island Highway northwesterly along the left bank of Small Creek (local name). (25-foot trail)

#### **EIN 105a**

A campsite adjacent to Kodiak Island Highway at the head of trail EIN 105. (one-acre site) GPS coordinates of the NW corner are Lat 57° 35' 45.7"N Long 152° 28' 45.0"W

#### **EIN 106**

A proposed trail running northwesterly from Saltery Cove Road. (25-foot trail)

#### **EIN 106a**

A campsite adjacent to Saltery Cove Road at the head of trail EIN 106. (one-acre site)

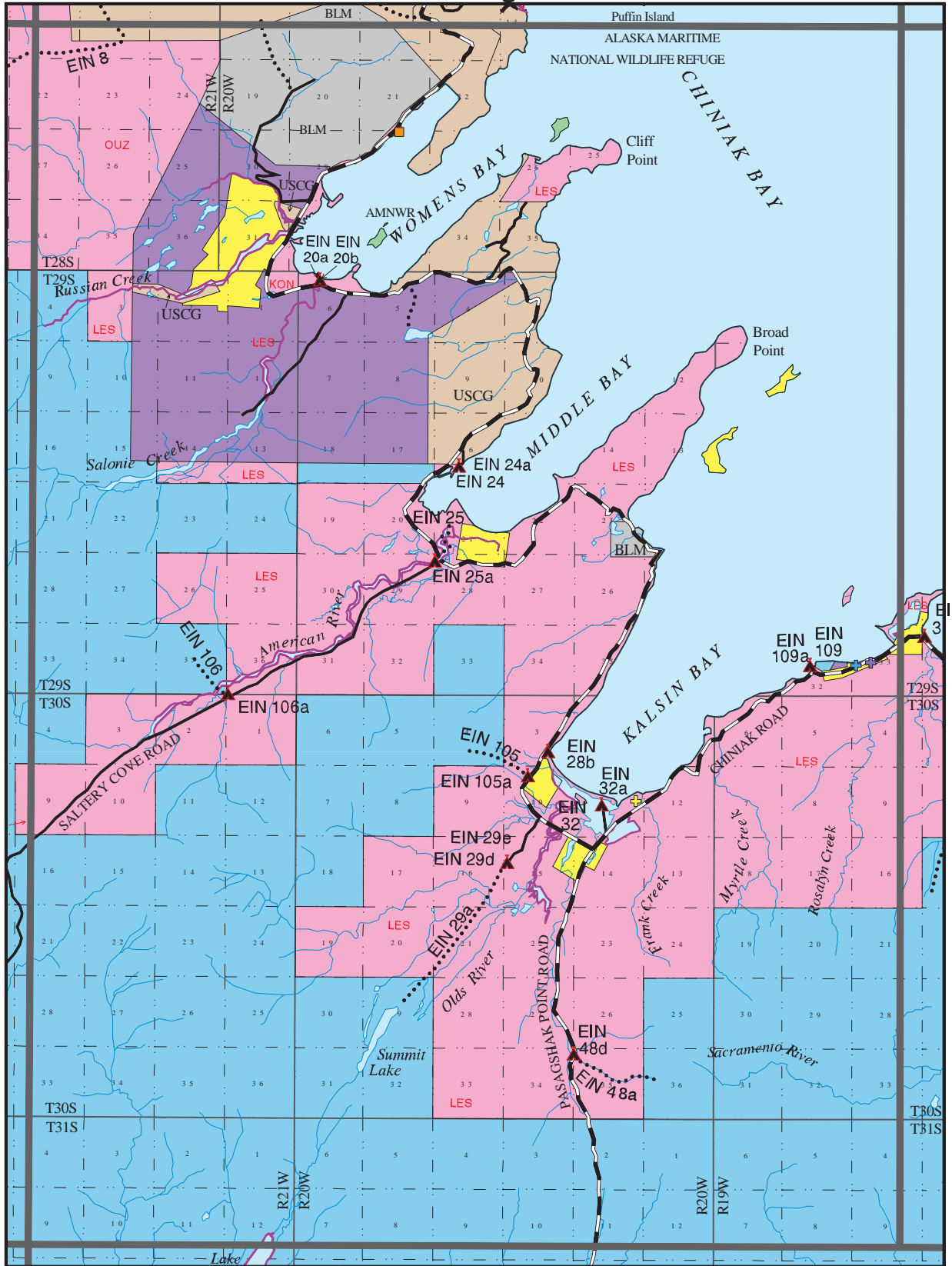
#### **EIN 109**

An existing road running northwesterly from Chiniak Road to Kalsin Bay and site EIN 109a. (60-foot road)

#### **EIN 109a**

A campsite on the shore Kalsin Bay at the end of road EIN 109. (one-acre site) GPS coordinates of the SW corner are Lat 57° 37' 3.2"N Long 152° 22' 13.5"W
