- You can use the *Land Records Search Utility* and the *Land Case Files and Abstracts* to identify the status and history of a casefile.
- The casefile type and number are normally located in the bottom right corner of the Title Block on a plat.
- There will be dashes in EV casefile numbers but generally there are no dashes in other casefile types. Dashes may be present in the title of a survey but not the casefile number, e.g., survey title: ASLS No. 2009-12 and survey casefile number: ASLS 20090012.
