South Fork Trail	Open	5"	24"-36"	Groomed 3/3 Chena river crossing at mile 1 is frozen however, the river does still have open leads
Stiles Creek Trail	Open	5"	24"-36"	Groomed 3/3 Drifting in higher elevations between Cabin and shooting range.
Granite Tors Trail	Non- Motorized	5"	24"-36"	trail not maintained in winter, unknown conditions
Compeau Trail	Open	5"	24"-36"	Groomed on 3/3
Mastodon Trail	Non- Motorized	5"	24"-36"	Unbroked since most recent snow

Average snow depth is recorded uncompressed.

If you plan to use the trails, please be prepared for and have the gear for changing conditions to include unbroken trails with deep snows, blowdowns/fallen tree limbs, open water, overflow ice, and more. Winter recreation, trail use, and all ice crossing safety is not implied and at the risk of the individual.

Be prepared for winter driving conditions on Chena Hot Springs Road, especially beyond Pleasant Valley.
