Overall Conditions: Trails are clear and parks are open

General Information: A \$5 per person entrance fee for Totem Bight State Historical Park is required, which can be paid at our kiosks. Settlers Cove Campground is \$20/Day and Firewood is \$5 a Bundle which can be purchased at the kiosk in the lower parking lot. Cabin rental can be found at alaskastateparks.reserveamerica.com . Fees go to maintenance to keep parks safe and open. Leash law in effect in developed areas. Trail obstructions can be reported by calling (907)247-8574.

Settlers Cove State Recreation Site: Campgrounds	Campsite Road is reopened; park condition is normal campsites are open.
Settlers Cove Lunch Creek Trail	Conditions: normal, Slight rain washout on stairs, Trail is clear,
Settlers Cove Lunch Creek Loop	Conditions are rough, with loose boards on parts of the trail. Trail repairs is currently being conducted.
Black Sands Beach State Recreational Area	Conditions are normal. Park as usual. The Park is remote
Grant & Joe Island State Marine Park	Conditions normal, Park as usual, Park undeveloped and remote
Betton Island State Marine Park	Conditions normal, Park as usual, Park undeveloped and remote
Dall Bay State Marine Park	Conditions normal, Park as usual, Park undeveloped and remote
Grindall Island State Marine Park	Conditions normal, park as usual, Cabin open for reservation
