<p>Ft. Abercrombie State Historical Park</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -The Spruce Cabin is now available for rent through May 15 -Some trail puncheons are bouncy on the Parkside and Connector trails, plans are underway for repair this spring/summer -All trail paths are clear but may be icy, please use caution when hiking -Gate to Campgrounds and Miller Point Rd. are closed for the winter
<p>Buskin River State Recreation Site</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Campgrounds are open -Please drive slowly through the rec site, roads and parking lots may be icy -Roads are not maintained in the winter, please use caution when traveling
<p>Pasagshak River State Recreation Site</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -The Coho Cabin is now available for rent -The Paseraq Cabin has experienced some wall leaking during major wind and rain events, plans are underway to seal logs in spring/summer. -A small bear has been spotted around the rec site recently, last reported 01/22/25. -Roads to Pasagshak may be icy, please use caution when traveling
<p>Woody Island State Recreation Ste</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -The Tangirnammi Cabin can be reserved online -Trail from Salt Lake to the cabin is primitive -Trail crossing at Crab Lagoon is inaccessible in 8ft.+ tides -Please check weather and tide conditions before traveling to Woody Island

A \$5 parking fee is required at Ft.Abercrombie SHP, Buskin River SRS, and Pasagshak River SRS, which can be paid at our kiosks.

Fees go towards keeping our parks maintained and safe for everyone.
