Ft. Abercrombie State Historical Park	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Trails and parking lot may be icy, microspikes are recommended. -Ice on Lake Gertrude is <u>unstable.</u> -Roads and parking lot have been plowed. -Gates to Miller Point and Campgrounds are closed for the winter, drive safe!
Buskin River State Recreation Site	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Campgrounds are open -Please drive slowly through the recreation site, roads are snowy and icy. -Roads are not regularly maintained through the winter, drive safe!
Pasagshak River State Recreation Site	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Campgrounds are open -Please drive slowly through the recreation site, roads may be snowy and icy. -Roads are not regularly maintained though the winter, drive safe!
Woody Island State Recreation Ste	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -The mooring buoy at Woody Island State Recreation Site was damaged and removed -The Tangirname Cabin can be reserved online -Trail from Salt Lake to the cabin is primitive -Trail crossing at Crab Lagoon is inaccessible in 8ft.+ tides -Please check weather and tide conditions before traveling to Woody Island

General Information:

A \$5 parking fee is required at Ft.Abercrombie SHP, Buskin River SRS, and Pasagshak River SRS, which can be paid at our kiosks.

Fees go towards keeping our parks maintained and safe for everyone.
