**\*\*Average snow depth recorded is uncompressed.** Snowmobile openings are based on the snowpack's ability to protect underlying vegetation and include: depth measurements, snow density, wind loading, temperatures, forecast, terrain, topography, elevation, and snow base and ice conditions. River and lake **ice crossing safety is not implied** and at the risk of the individual.

**Conditions update:**

No new snow in the past week and spring conditions continue. Expect firm snow conditions in the morning with softer, heavier snow in the afternoon when the sun may affect the snowpack. With the warmer temperatures this week, the snowpack has been reduced by a couple of inches. It is snowing lightly this morning (3-23) but little to no accumulation is forecasted.

Highway vehicles are prohibited on Nancy Lake Pkwy beyond the winter trailhead (mile 2.2) during the winter season. Please park at the winter trailhead.

A \$5 day-use fee or annual parking pass is required at most trailheads throughout the park. Please respect private properties adjacent to park land.
