General Information:

Shuyak Island is a pristine, remote, wilderness haven. Big Bay boasts sheltered waters, ideal for kayaking or packrafting, while the park's maintained trails provide fantastic hiking opportunities. Shuyak Island is a top destination for hiking, kayaking, birding, fishing, and hunting.

The Big Bay Ranger Station is manned from June through August by parks staff and volunteers. You may see them working on the trails or making repairs to cabins. Feel free to stop by the ranger station during your visit!

Shuyak Island can be subject to unpredictable weather. Poor weather can delay flights to and from the park so all visitors are encouraged to pack extra food and supplies in case they get weathered in. It is recommended to have at least one electronic communication device such as a satellite phone or portable satellite communication system.

Be prepared for bear encounters during any season. Use caution, avoid surprise encounters, and follow all bear safety etiquette. Do not leave any food items or trash outside of cabins. Discard all fish and animal entrails in the ocean.

Leave no trace, or better yet, better than you found it!
We want to keep Shuyak Island a beautiful and wild place to visit.
Please pack out everything you pack in to the cabins.
