Wood-Tikchik State Park

Date 3/15/24

Wood-Tikchik State Park is open to snowmobile use as there is adequate snow depth to protect underlying vegetation and use of snowmobiles does not present a hazard to other park users and park resources.

Snowmobile openings are based on amount of packed snow base and vegetation coverage.

Please Note: A \$5.00 day use parking fee or annual parking pass is required at the Lake Aleknagik State Recreation Site. The annual parking pass can be purchased online. Annual Day Use Parking Passes are available at <https://dnr.alaska.gov/parks/passes>

Backcountry Users: Wood-Tikchik State Park is an **AVALANCHE HAZARD AREA**. Be aware of the avalanche conditions and be sure to take your beacon, probes, and shovels and be knowledgeable of their use.

BE PREPARED. Remember hypothermia is a life-threatening problem. Safe traveling can prevent backcountry emergencies and costly search and rescues. Always let someone know where you are going and know the hazards of the area you are traveling in. Travel with a pack containing safety gear and emergency provisions.
