- Have a valid driver's license and be an Alaska Resident, 18 or older
- Be able to lift 50lbs and hike several miles a day
- Be willing to travel by boat and small aircraft
- Be willing to work at remotes sites and overnight in tent or cabin
- Be willing to learn how to operate chainsaws and other power tools
