5. Public Comments:

- Will Taygan CMBR
 - Re: Muktuk Marston Signage plus bike racks at the top Hunter Pass
 - Hired Happy Trails to look at Rendezvous Ridge and improve for bike access, expect to see a report fall 2025
 - Interest in Ship Creek trail becoming bike legal, could do a loop from Powerline Pass to Arctic Valley
 - Challenge AK interested in adaptive-bicycle compatibility, current class 2 should be sufficient
 - Ben improving trail is consistent with management plan, wilderness corridors require a minimum
 - Currently if trail is open to bikes, it is open to class 1 e-bikes
- Casey Durand Alaska Glamping Eklutna
 - o Interest in selfie-station
 - Parking lot, Bold Ridge TH, Glen Alps, Powerline Pass
 - QR code to go to CPF
 - Casey wouldn't want help/funding for maintenance

- Interest in improving latrine facilities at Eklutna
 - Wants a letter of support, include service contract
 - Irene motion to write a letter of support for grant for latrine, Stephanie

- Robin Dublin Basher Community Council
 - Fire mitigation, former CAB, community patrol. Pulling in to TH's with magnetic decals and flashing lights, get some cars to leave, help prevent break-ins.
 - Call 311 or CSP, visual presence at THs.
 - Interest in Chugach State Park community patrol
 - Fuel reduction on 150' on either side of Campbell Airstrip Road from Campbell Airstrip TH to Basher TH, shade-break style
 - Questions on Basher TH expansion project, concerns about break ins
 - Community Patrol is sponsored by Muni
 - Very early stages for parking lot improvements at Basher, Ben assures Robin those considerations will be taken into account
- Cathy Hammon South Fork ER
 - Concerned with recent letter supporting bike use on Muktuk Marston
 - Hunter Pass trail project in 2021-2022
 - Didn't see minutes or recordings online
 - Concern about public input given the age of the Trails Management Plan
 - Muktuk Marston is on the map and in the trail management plan
 - There already existing issues with bikers on SFER
 - Trail plan came out for public comment 2009, formalized in 2016
 - Clark Saunders (CAB is also on the SFER CC), mentioned that the SFER CC also submitted a letter supporting a regulation change to allow bikes on Muktuk Marston

- Regulations go through a public comment period, currently drafting regulations, unclear when that will be

8. Staff Report:

• Park Management

- Clearing downed trees across Chugach trails after the recent windstorm.
- O No snow machine areas open due to lack of snow.
- Extreme overflow conditions on Canyon Road. Similar conditions on both Briggs and access to Indian Valley.
- o Routine cabin maintenance across all park cabins.
- Coordinating with Wendy and Park Specialist to host/ help out with public outreach event coming up.
- Mary Gianotti hosted her Avalanche Rescue workshop this past weekend at Glen Alps. There was over 100 people who attended!
- CSP issued NSAA a permit to groom sections of the Anchorage Hillside Trail
 System. They brought up a Piston Bully and groomed from Upper Huffman, up
 Silver Fern, Gasline to Powerline and then a loop around the Glen Alps Access
 Trails.
- CSP also decided to renew Alaskan Glamping permit for this coming year. I met with Casey a couple of weeks ago and it sounded like operations went smoothly last year with no issues to report. They had 77 bookings last season.
- o ERNC's Icy River Rampage was another success this year. 71 participants.

Maintenance

- Ongoing work on two main host cabins at Eagle River and Bird Point.
- New skid steer has arrived.

• Law Enforcement & Public Safety

- o Search & Rescue: Keith and Tim assisted with a SAR operation at Eagle River.
- o Illegal Fires: Prevented a pallet fire at Kokanee.
- Security Measures: Game camera and locked put at North Fork gate to deter partying.

 Squatter & Abandoned Vehicle Removal: Rangers removed squatters and cleared an abandoned vehicle from the south end.

- Hiring Process Started for the summer trail crew and park aide.
- South 1/3 of Eklutna was open water two weeks ago
- Clearing trails
- Canyon Road TH was very icy, multiple vehicles
- 2 rangers out on military leave
- Vandalism discovered, Bird Creek campround, North Fork, Peter's Creek, campfire burned out of control at Eklutna, car fire at Glen Alps, Bird Creek construction - speed enforcement
- Mostly just warnings for trailhead stickers
- Rogue motorized use on Hillside, ranger Kellen caught an electric dirt bike on Saturday, reports of tracked scooters
- Camp up Peter's Creek at 4-mile bowl
- Sublegal moose going to trial in 2 weeks
- Multiple motorist assists
- I have made the extremely tough decision to resign from my position as park superintendent. It has been a rewarding 16 years with parks. Together with the help of an amazing staff and dedicated CAB, we have done a lot, to which I am very proud. My new position will be Director of Land with Aleut.
