



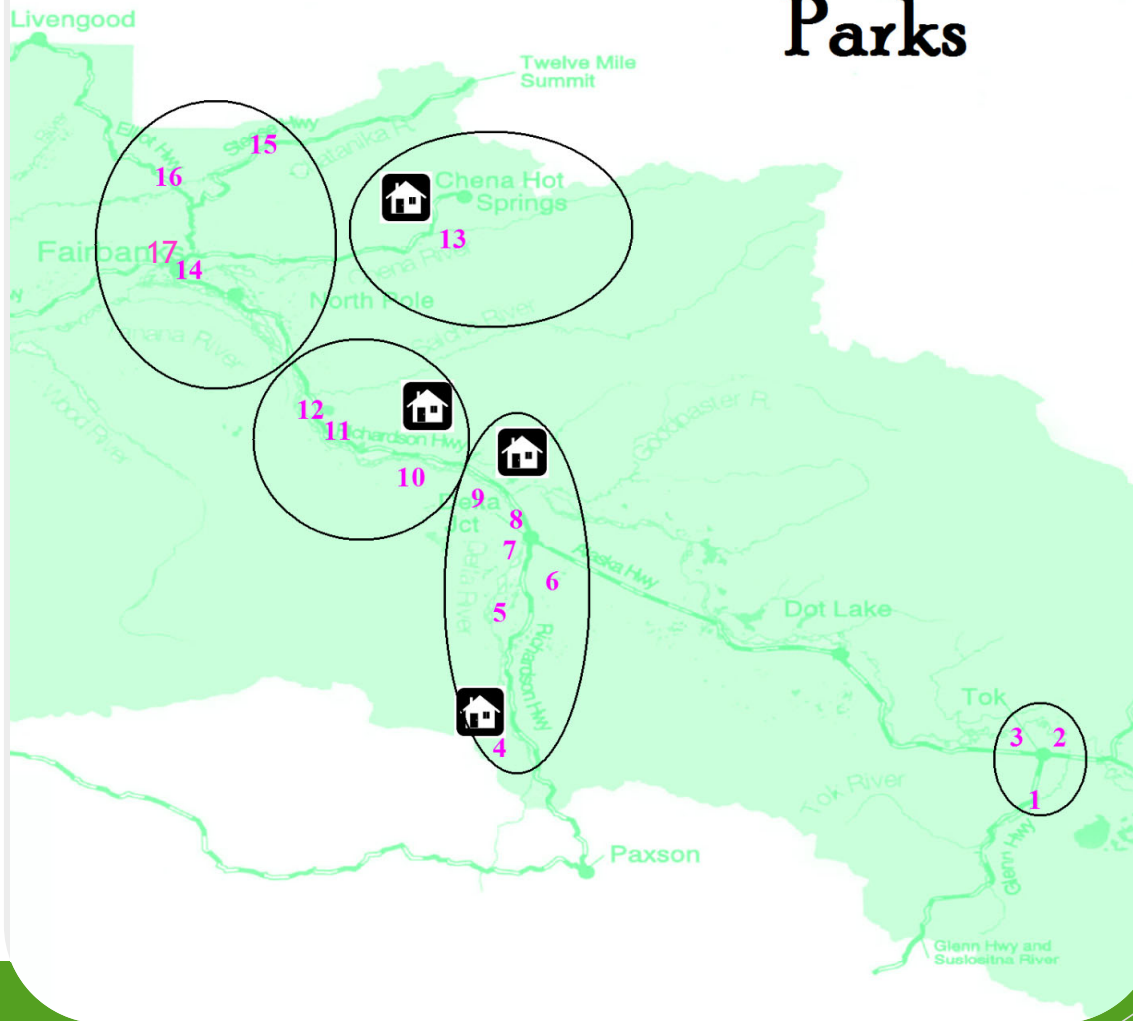

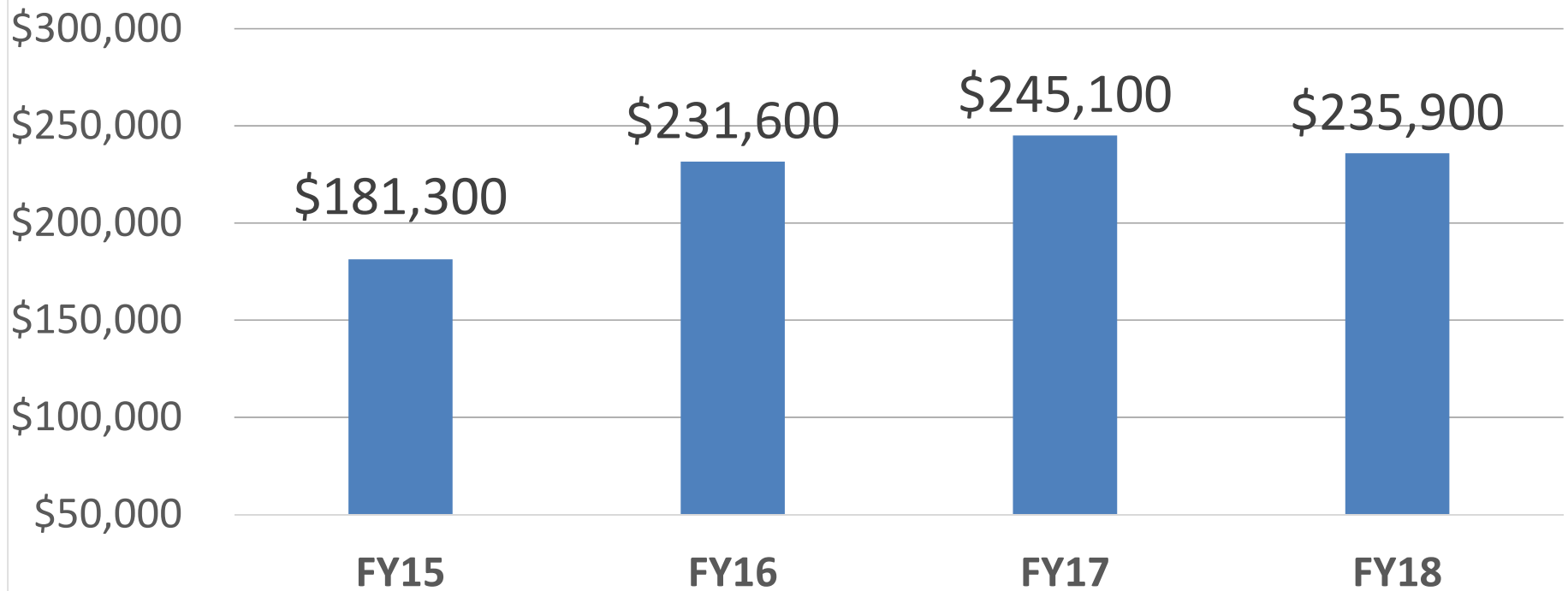

17 Park units:

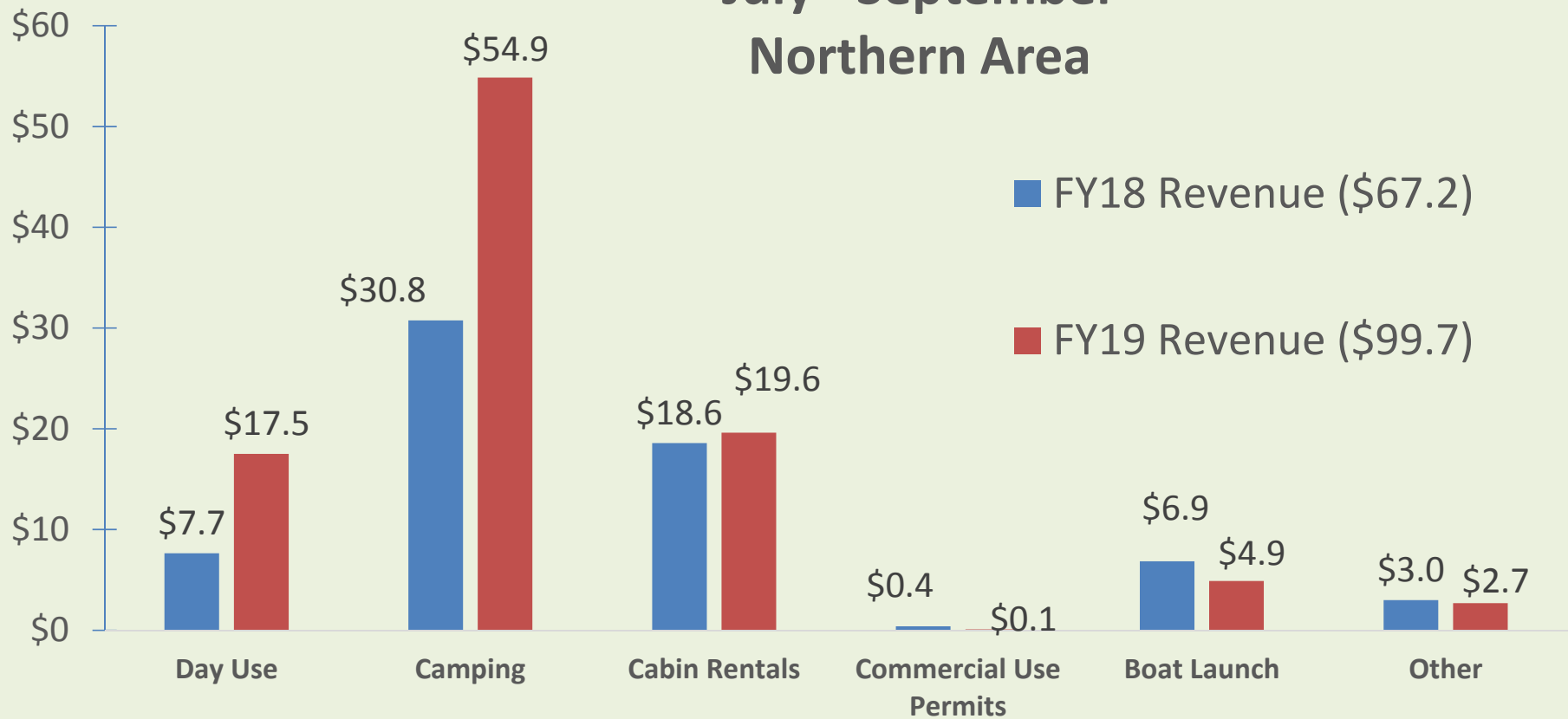
- 11 Boat launches on 4 rivers and 6 lakes

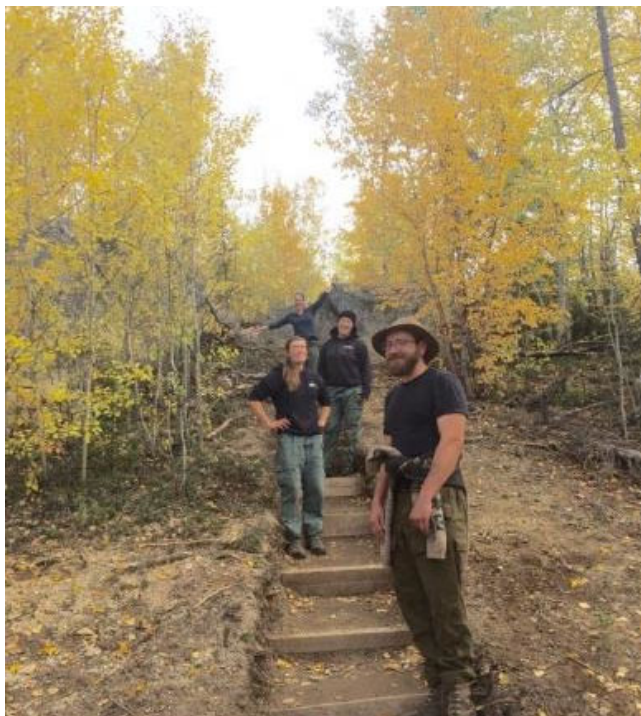

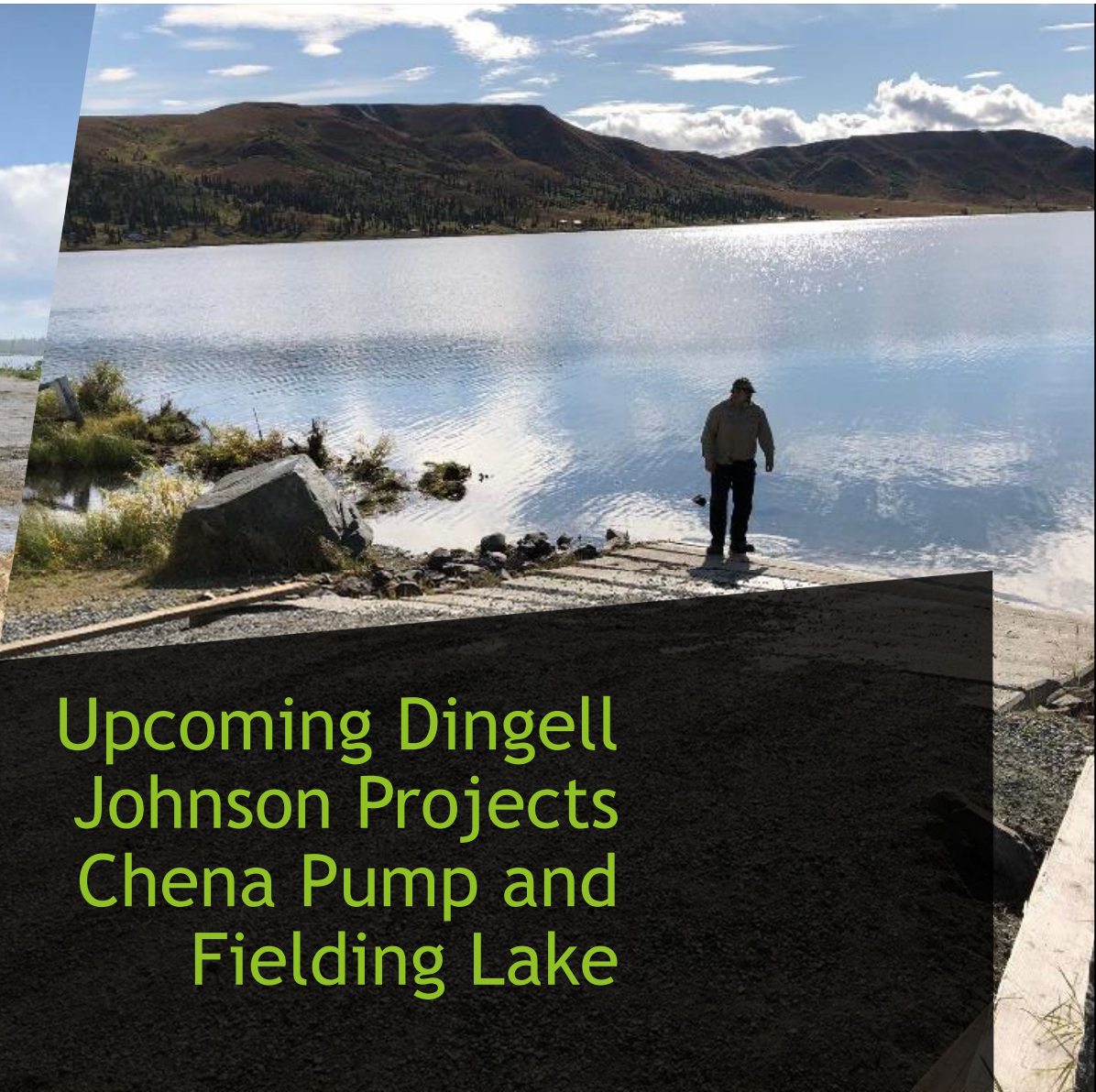
