SD 18-2-30A9BD1-

- 0 - 5 feet.....Top Soil
- 5 - 16 feet.....Gravel
- 16 - 70½ feet.....Hardpan
- 70½ - 97 feet.....Water and pea gravel

Pail tested at 20 gallons per minute.

Set pump 4 feet off bottom of well.

WELL #2

- 0 - 5 feet.....Top soil
- 5 - 18 feet.....Gravel
- { 18 - 48 feet.....Hardpan
- { 48 - 50 feet.....Boulders and hardpan
- 50 - 51 feet.....Boulders and a little water
- 51 - 52 feet.....Hardpan and a little water
- 52 - 53 feet.....Clay and rock
- 53 - 55 feet.....Hardpan
- { 55 - 63 feet.....Water and gravel
- { 63 - 76 feet.....Gravel and water

Pulled 8 feet of casing and set 12 feet of #10 slot screen.

Set pump 2 feet from bottom of screen.
